Ms. Carpenter was born and raised in Germany and started her journey into family history many years ago. She continues to research her own family in Germany, plus the family of her Scots-Irish husband in the United States. She received her M.A. in German Language and Literature, and her teaching credentials, from the California State University, Sacramento. She is also a proud veteran of the US Air Force.

She is especially interested in the social history of our ancestors, with a focus on women, and loves to tell stories of their lives, where and how they lived, and how the vagaries of history affected their personal circumstances. In addition to lectures, she translates historical documents, and teaches the Old German script, *Kurrent*.

She is a board member of the Sacramento German Genealogical Society (SSGS), the International German Genealogy Partnership (IGGP), and the Sacramento Turn Verein.
